Channel Drive, and Rockaway Point Boulevard. These
roads are major arteries flowing through Broad

Channel and the Rockaways, but, unlike other roads in the City, they contain long stretches where there are no cross streets or other definable geographic markers, making it difficult for all road users who may be stranded to identify their precise location.

The addition of mile-markers at 1/10th of a mile intervals along these roads will correct that problem. It will ensure that any road users who may be stranded can easily communicate their location to emergency personnel. This is a commonsense bill that will assist those who live in Broad Channel and the Rockaways and the many who come to visit our communities as well. I look forward to voting on this proposed bill.
