7 CHAIRPERSON FARÍAS: Good morning. Today is November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023. My name is Amanda Farías and 8 9 I have the privilege of chairing the Council's 10 Committee on Economic Development. The purpose of 11 today's hearing is to vote on a critical piece of 12 legislation I sponsored regarding strategic planning for industrial sector growth in our city. This bill 13 14 was first heard by this Committee in June of this 15 year, and since then, my office has worked closely 16 with the Council's Land Use Division, the 17 Administration, and industrial sector advocates to 18 refine the legislation into the updated version 19 before us today. Proposed Intro 1012A would require the Departments of City Planning and Small Business 20 21 Services in coordination with the Economic 2.2 Development Corporation to develop a comprehensive 23 citywide industrial development strategic plan every 24 five years. The Department of City Planning has not 25 undertaken a comprehensive study of industrial sector

1 COMMITTEE ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT 4 conditions and needs since 1993, meaning this 2 3 legislation will fill a three-decade gap. The industrial sector is critical to New York City's 4 economy, infrastructure, and daily functioning. 5 Industrial jobs also offer pathways to the middle 6 7 class for hundreds of thousands of New Yorkers with a workforce that is over 80 percent people of color. 8 9 However, from zoning and land use policy to economic development programs, efforts to support industrial 10 11 businesses in New York City remain siloed and uncoordinated. There is also a lack of recent 12 13 comprehensive data and analysis to inform policy-14 This bill would mandate regular collection making. 15 of economic and land use data related to industrial 16 business zones across the five boroughs. Based on 17 this updated data and coordination across agencies, 18 the industrial development strategic plan would then 19 outline strategies and recommendations regarding 20 economic development goals, land use objects, 21 workforce development programs, and infrastructure investments. By taken a coordinated data-driven 2.2 23 approach to sustaining and growing the City's industrial businesses and jobs, this legislation will 24 offer long overdue support to a vital sector of our 25

3	keeps pace with major transitions already underway,							
4	like capital investments in sustainable							
5	infrastructure and facilitating the City's shift to
