SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Good morning and welcome to the New York City Council vote of the Committee on Finance.

At this time, can everybody please silence your cell phones?

Chair, we are ready to begin.

CHAIRPERSON BRANNAN: [GAVEL] Good morning. Welcome to today's Finance Committee hearing. I'm Council Member Justin Brannan. I have the privilege of Chairing the Committee on Finance.

We've been joined this morning by Council Members Carr, Hudson, Farías, Brooks-Powers, Won, Louis, Ossé, Brewer, and Williams. We have been joined on Zoom by Council Members Moya and Sanchez.

Today, the Committee will be voting on four property tax exemptions. The first is a full 40-year Article XI exemption for new construction of one 100 percent affordable rental building in Council Member Nurse's District. The building will have 127 rent-restricted units with 45 units set aside for homeless referrals.

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The second is for a partial 40-year

Article V exemption for 12 buildings in Council

Member Gutiérrez's District. The exemption would

renew a previous Article V exemption for the complex

retroactive to the date of expiration.

The third is for a full 40-year Article
XI exemption for two buildings in Council Member
Abreu's and De La Rosa's Districts. The exemption
will allow for a substantial rehabilitation of
bathrooms, repair of the roof and the sidewalks and
new boiler and hot water heaters. Both buildings will
be placed under an HPD regulatory agreement setting
rent and income restrictions as well as reserve 15
percent of the units for homeless referrals and
impose HPD's Aging in Place initiative.

The final resolution is a partial 40-year Article V exemption for three buildings in Council Member Richardson Jordan's District. The buildings had been operating under an Article V exemption which expired in 2020, and the resolution would grant a new exemption retroactive to the date of expiration.
