Chair, we are ready to begin.

CHAIRPERSON SALAMANCA: [GAVEL] All right, good afternoon and welcome to the Committee on Land Use. I am Rafael Salamanca, Jr., the Chair of this Committee.

I would like to welcome our esteemed

Colleagues who have joined us today. We've been

joined by Council Members Moya, Chair Louis, Abreu,

Brooks-Powers, Bottcher, Hanks, Krishnan, Mealy,

Sanchez, and Borelli.

I would like to thank Chair Louis and Chair Riley for their work on our two Subcommittees.

Today, we are voting to approve LU 281 for the 506 West 135th ANCP proposal in Council Member Abreu's District in Manhattan. This proposal by the HPD would facilitate the renovation of three

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buildings in Upper Manhattan resulting in 63affordable cooperative homeownership units.

We will also vote to approve LUS 282 and 283 regarding the Linden Gardens proposal in Council Member Nurse's District and Council Member Barron's District in Brooklyn. This is a proposal by HPD for a UDAAP approval and a related real property tax exemption approval to facilitate an afford homeownership project with approximately 37 affordable cooperative units.

We will also vote to approve LU 292 regarding an Article XI real property tax exemption request by HPD for New Penn development in Council Member Barron's District in Brooklyn. This tax exemption would facilitate the previously approved New Penn project yielding a total of 71 affordable units.

We will vote to approve LU 293 for the West 120th-126th Street ANCP cluster proposal by HPD in Council Member Richardson Jordans' District in Manhattan. This proposal would facilitate the substantial renovation and preservation of 48 affordable cooperative homeownership units in four buildings.

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We will vote to approve two SCA site plan submissions, LU 294 for a new 676-seat high school facility in Council Member Brannan's District in Brooklyn, and LU 295 for a new 696-seat public school facility in Council Member Ung's District in Queens.

Finally, we will vote to approve with modifications LUs 296 and 297 for the 541-545 Bay Street proposal in Council Member Hanks' District in Staten Island. The proposal includes a zoning map amendment and the relating zoning text amendment to facilitate the development of a new mixed-use building with approximately 81 apartments and ground floor commercial use. As discussed by the Zoning Subcommittee and reflective of Council Member Hanks' statement on affordability, our modification will be to remove MIH Workforce Option while retaining Option 1 and Option 2.

At this time, I'm willing to welcome my Colleagues who might wish to ask questions or make remarks.

Seeing none, I now call for a vote with the support of local Council Members to approve LUs 281, 282, 283, 292, 293, 294, and 295, and to approve
