and whether there were any involuntary removals or arrests.

According to a recent audit by the New York City Comptroller, sweeps of homeless and campus were found to do little when it came to connecting those experiencing homelessness on our streets with City services or with a permanent housing, yet thousands of sweeps occur each year. The bill will help us to better understand which agencies are conducting the sweeps and what types of services are being offered to unsheltered people.
