We had the hearings already on these two items land use number 360 C0909225ZMK and land use 361 C110118ZMK. And these two items Council Member Lander was working on to try to get agreement and everything in order and I'm happy to say I have a letter here of support from Council Member Lander, which it the committee doesn't mind I will read into the record and then I will introduce the members of the committee that are here which I haven't done yet.

But this is to Chair Weprin and the members of the Zoning and Franchises Committee.

Thank you for your consideration of the proposed rezoning of 25 and 33 Carroll Street in Brooklyn and for your flexibility, we're all very flexible, in allowing an additional week to resolve these items.

I apologize for not being there this morning, and for making you guys come just for my meeting actually I added that, but [laughter] I want you to know that thanks to the extra week, they had enormous progress and I'm pleased as to ask you to vote yes on these items.

As noted at the public hearing last week the owner of 33 Carroll Street a privately owned lot with the rezoning law allow 8 new market rate units has agreed to deepen the affordability of the least six units on nearby sites, where he has been designated as a developer under HPD new foundation's program. My 20 percent of AMI thus enabling low income families to stay in our community and committed to permanent affordability.

At 25 Carroll Street with a

2 rezoning will allow the owner to convert the 3 relatively small ground floor of a mixed-use

4 building into residential use. The owner has

5 agreed to contribute \$20,000 for physical

6 improvements at the Urban Meadow, a community

garden, small park around the corner.

As a result, this small rezoning will make contributions to affordable housing and neighborhood open space. I thank both developers Marshall Sloan [phonetic] at 33 Carroll Street and Alex Barrett [phonetic] of 25 Carroll, for working with us and the community.

I want to especially thank Michael Freedman-Schnapp, who is here today, of my staff. Michael take the brow. Who's creativity and persistence made this possible as well as Richard Bearak from Borough President Marty Markowitz's Office, who was instrumental in the agreement of 33 Carroll street. Thanks also to HPD, to the Council's land use staff, and again to you and members of the subcommittee, as well as all the general public. I, enthusically, I added that as well, I ask you to vote yes on this rezoning site.
