very much Mr. Chairman are one of thank you and all the members of this committee and of Chair Weprin's subcommittee for your extra time both on Tuesday and today. I am very grateful and my residence of my community are very grateful for the extra time and that is why we indeed have munchkin here which I hope both members and staff who would like when avail themselves of. Chairman you'll know there are new toys provided with the box of munchkins.

The extra week did make a big

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difference in getting a good deal on these two
properties of developers are both 25 and 33
Carroll Streets have made significant improvements
to this project at 33 Carroll where eight market
rate units are developed the developer has agreed
to deepen the affordability on six units in other
developments nearby and make them permanently
affordable and HPD has consented to that

And a 25 Carroll Street where the owner is being allowed to convert the ground floor of a building from manufacturing into residential, he's agreed to make a \$20,000 contribution for improvements to a community garden on the block.

None of which is in place by last, so thank you very much for the additional week.

With that I want to thank the developers they are Marshall Slone [phonetic] known at 33 Carroll and Alex Barrett [phonetic] at 25 Carroll, as well as Richard Bearak from the Borough President's Office and Freedman-Schnapp which is part of my staff, as well as HPD and the Council's land use that for helping make all of that possible.

They're small projects but still I
