COMMITTEE: State and Federal Legislation

Title: AN ACT to amend chapter 130 of the laws of 1998, amending the general municipal law relating to temporary investments by local governments, in relation to extending the expiration of the provisions thereof.

SPONSORS: Council Member Foster

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION: Extends to 2014 the law, which allows the city flexibility and the types of instruments it uses to invest.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would take effect immediately; provided however, if this act shall have become a law after July 1, 2011 it shall be deemed to have been in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2011.
