CHAIRPERSON BREWER: Thank you very
much. I'm Gale Brewer, City Council Member and
chair of Governmental Operations and I'm joined
here by Council Member Domenic Recchia, Council
Member Peter Vallone and great staff, Seth
Grossman in particular, counsel to the Committee.
We're here to vote out legislation 361-A that
would make city government even more transparent-
something this Speaker and this City Council has
worked really hard on. I think the public may not
know that executive orders and what we call
memorandums of understanding, MOU being the
acronym, sometimes have a lot of impact on city
government and on policy.

This legislation would apply to all executive orders effective on or after January 1<sup>st</sup> 1974—when I started working in government—and subject to foil [phonetic] exemption and all memorandum of understanding effective on or before July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010. I want to also add that the executive orders issued on or after July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 shall be provided to the Council and posted on the City's website within five business days from the date of execution.
