2 CHAIRPERSON FERRERAS: Good

morning. My name is Julissa Ferreras, chair of the Women's Issues Committee. This morning we're going to vote on Resolution 817, a pre-considered resolution in support of pending legislation in the New York State Legislature, which would amend the penal and criminal procedures of law by creating an E felony of aggravated domestic violence when an offender is convicted of two or more specified domestic violence offenses within five years. Please let it be noted that this preconsidered resolution is in support of the Assembly Bill 1986 and its companion bill in the Senate, 5617-A, not Senate Bill 1510 as indicated during yesterday's hearing. This was a typo and the substance of the bill remains the same. addition, Reso 817 is now 817-A. It's supporting the same legislation and purpose; however, we have added the specific state number. Yesterday on June 13th, 2011, the Women's Issues Committee joined with the Public Safety Committee and conducted a robust and informative hearing on these two resolutions, which take significant steps to combat domestic violence by either

2	providing services to domestic violence victims or
3	punishing domestic violence abusers. The
4	Committees invited the administration, district
5	attorney's offices, domestic violence advocates
6	and concerned members of the community to testify.
