2	CHAIRPERSON RECCHIA: Okay. You
3	ready? Good morning. Welcome to today's Finance
4	Committee meeting. My name is Domenic M.
5	Recchia, Jr. I'm the chair of this Committee.
6	Today we have ten items on our agenda and I'm
7	sorry that we're starting so late, but it's the
8	budget and we have many different hearings and
9	many different meetings. I'd like to introduce my
LO	colleagues, who have joined us here today. We
11	have Jimmy Van Bramer. We have Darlene Mealy. We
L2	have Oliver Koppell. We have Fernando Cabrera.
L3	We have Lewis Fidler. We have Julissa Ferreras.
L4	Did I get it right?
L5	COUNCIL MEMBER FERRERAS: Ferreras.
L6	CHAIRPERSON RECCHIA: Ferreras. I
L7	said that. I'm getting better. Leroy Comrie and
18	Rob Jackson. Thank you very much for all coming
L9	here and joining us today.
20	First we have 5 pre-considered
21	resolutions relating to interest and discount
22	rates on early and late payments for property
23	taxes and water and sewer rents. These rates are
24	based in part on the recommendations we received
25	from the Banking Commission. We will vote on five

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Banking Commission resolutions to establish the
following: 1) that the discount percentage for
early payment of real estates' taxes be set at 1%
at the interest rate for non-payment of taxes on
properties with an assessed value of 250,000 or
less be set at 9%, 3) that the interest rate for
non-payment of taxes on properties with an
assessed value of over 250,000 bet set at 18%, 4)
that the interest rate for non-payment of water
and sewer rents on properties with an assessed
value of 250,000 or less be 9% and 5) that the
interest rate for non-payment of water rents and
sewer rents for properties with an assessed value
of over 250,000 be set at 18%.

Second, we have four Land Use resolutions. The first resolution will provide for new construction of an undetermined number of units low income families as 530 West 45th Street in Manhattan. This resolution is in Speaker Quinn's district and she supports it.

The second resolution will provide for 108 units of rental housing for low-income families located at 315-331 East 29th Street in Manhattan, known as Phipps Housing. This

2 resolution is in Council Member Mendez's district 3 and she supports this.

The third resolution will provide for a 7 story building, 58 units of rental housing for low-income families located at 3247 Johnson Avenue in the Bronx, known as Hudson House. The resolution is in Council Member Koppell's district and he supports this item.

The fourth and last resolution will provide for two buildings with 42 units of rental housing for low-income families located at 743 Driggs Avenue in Brooklyn known as Los Sures in Council Member Diana Reyna's district. This resolution makes a technical amendment to a resolution adopted by the Council in April. In the April resolution, the starting day for the resolution was effective six months too soon. This resolution clarifies the starting date of the exemption and is supported by Council Member Reyna.

Our final item relates to the adopted fiscal 2011-2010 Expense Budget. This resolution sets forth new designations or changes of certain organizations receiving local aging and

youth discretionary funding, as well as new
designation or changes in the designation of
certain organizations that receive funding
pursuant to certain initiatives in the fiscal
2011-2010 Expense Budget. For clarification
purposes, it is to be noted that the organizations
appearing in resolutions that have not yet
completed the prequalification process conducted
by the Mayor's Office of Contractor Services, by
the Council or any other entity are identified in
the attached charts with an asterisk.
Additionally as well as all transparency
resolution, Council Members will have to sign a
disclosure statement indicating whether there's a
conflict that exists. If any member has a
potential conflict with any organization listed,
he or she might want to disclose the conflict at
the time of the voteCouncil Members that they
are now required to disclose at the time of the
vote. This disclosure must be made by the
subcontractor as well. Members of the Finance
Committee are available to answer any questions,
if you have resulting transparency resolutions.

13	331 East 29 th Street, and this would be under the
14	inclusionary housing program. This would allow us
15	to preserve 208 units of affordable housing in my
16	district and I'm very supportive of it. Thank you
17	very much, Mr. Chair.
