The bottom line though when it was all over, I had to spend \$600 out of my pocket and he went back and I guess got another pizza to deliver to whoever he was being delivered to, but obviously having identification, having them registered with the police department, having the bikes to have a number, so for example, if something happened, someone can see the number so that the police will
