20	a modification to a previously approved
21	disposition to change the parking requirement. I

11	district. And so far, only in Brooklyn, Bedford-
12	Stuyvesant and Brownsville, and I believe Eastern
13	Bushwick and East New York is getting a whole, the
14	gamut of halfway houses. And I wish I could vote
15	on, well I will be voting on this, but I, I hope
16	everyone consider how many halfway houses are
17	coming into Brooklyn, and fair, to be fair, let it
18	be shared in every district, and not just certain
19	districts. Thank you.
20	CHAIRPERSON COMRIE: Thank you,
21	I'll just remind folks that this project,
22	particular project, was unanimously endorsed by
23	the Community Board, the Council Member, the
24	Borough President and everyone else that was
