3	today's Finance Committee hearing. My name is
4	Domenic M. Recchia, Jr. I'm the chair of this
5	wonderful Committee. At this time, I'd like to
6	recognize all the members that have joined us. To
7	my far left, we have Council Member Al Vann,
8	Council Member Robert Jackson, Council Member,
9	Gale Brewer. To my right, we have Council Member
10	Darlene Mealy, we have Council Member Leroy
11	Comrie, we have Council Member Oliver Koppell,
12	Council Member Karen Koslowitz and of course, my
13	good friend Council Member Joel Rivera, who I
14	missed. I'm sorry about that. We have from
15	Staten Island Council Member Vincent Ignizio and I
16	think we got everybody. As more Council Members
17	come, we will recognize those members.
18	Today we have a transparency
19	resolution, one Land Use item, a budget mod and
20	three property tax fixing resolutions. Let's
21	first start with the transparency resolution. The
22	transparency resolution makes mostly technical
23	corrections to the designations listed in Fiscal
24	2012 Schedule C and designates new organizations
25	under the faith-based imitative. For

2	clarification purposes, it is to be noted that
3	organizations appearing in the resolutions that
4	have not yet completed the prequalification
5	process conducted by the Mayor's Office of
6	Contract Services, by the Council or other
7	government agencies are identified in the attached
8	charts with an asterisk next to it. Additionally,
9	as with all transparency resos, Council Members
10	will have to sign disclosure form indicating
11	whether or not a conflict exists. If any Council
12	Member has potential conflict of interest with any
13	organization listed, he or she may want to
14	disclose that at the time of their vote.
15	We also have an expense budget mod
16	that is related to this transparency reso, as well
17	as past transparency resolutions. This mod is our
18	first budget mod relating to Fiscal 2012 Expense
19	Budget that we adopted in June. This mod
20	reallocates appropriations that were affected in
21	the FY 2012 Adopted Budget to fund City Council
22	initiatives. This mod only includes Council-
23	related items and does not include any item from
24	the administration. Without this modification
25	many organizations would not get their funding.

2	Items in today's transparency reso that require
3	budget mod in order for their funding to move
4	forward are referenced in the charts with a double
5	asterisk.
6	Now let's move to the Land Use
7	item. This Land Use itemthe Kelly Street
8	Apartments, located in the Bronx in Council Member
9	Maria del Carmen Arroyo's district. They'll
10	receive a property tax exemption for the rehab of
11	the property. The Kelly Street apartments will
12	provide 79 units of rental housing for low-income
13	families.
14	Our last three items on the agenda
15	are three tax fixing resos. Under current law, no
16	class shares of the real property tax levy can
17	increase by more than 5% from the previous year's
18	share. Governor Cuomo recently signed legislation
19	at the Council's request setting the class shares
20	cap for this year's property tax at 2.5%, rather
21	than the state law default of 5%. Under the
22	amended law, no class share of the real property
23	tax levy can increase by more than 2.5% from the
24	previous year's share. If the 2.5% cap were not
25	adopted, then the 5% cap would apply and the

2	typical taxpayer bills for a Class 1 property
3	would be \$97 higher. Class 2 is not affected by
4	this action today. So today we're amending the
5	three property tax fixing resos adopted on June
6	29th, 2011 to help make New York City a little
7	more affordable for Class 1 homeowners. I urge
8	all of my colleagues to vote yes on these amended
9	property tax resolutions. We are lowering the
10	taxes. I want to state that very clear. Okay? -
11	- from the Finance division is available to answer
12	any questions you may have on the property tax
13	reso. Preston Niblack, the director of the
14	Finance Division, is here to answer any questions
15	on the budget mod. Does anybody have any
16	questions? Without seeing any questions, call the
17	vote. I recognize Helen Diane Foster from the
18	Bronx joined us.
