allow Jet Blue to put up a sign letting folks know
that they exist at that site in Long Island City.
The Council District is 26Council Van Bramer,
who wholeheartedly supports this, along with
Community Boards 1 and 2. It's Item No. N10110223
ZRQ. The next item that we're doing is the Zone
Green text amendment [phonetic], Land Use Item No.
601. It's a city-wide application for amendment
of the zoning resolution of the city. It's Item
No. N120132 ZLY. It's a city-wide text amendment
to facilitate the retrofitting of existing
buildings and construction of new buildings with
green building This will allow people that
want to do green roofs and other green items to
improve energy efficiency to be able to do so,
the rules and regulations of the city.
