3	everyone. My name is Mark Weprin. I am the chair
4	of the Zoning and Franchises Subcommittee of the
5	Land Use Committee. We are going to have back to

Land Use and Planning. There was as you stated a
question regarding Fire Department regulations.
We reached out to the FDNY at this point have
gotten their FAQ in response to my question as to
the radius allowed around a fire escape drop
ladder. I believe a couple of Council Members had
a question about this yesterday, so we reached
out. At this point, we've gotten their FAQ, but I
think that this is an issue that we need further
clarification on, and I will work with counsel of
Land Use to sort of get that final determination
and at this point, we would recommend approval. I
would just like to say for the record, we heard
from a couple folks and Oliver has—I've talked to
Oliver, and we are going to reach out to his
neighbors to make sure that some of those concerns
that were mentioned yesterday and addressed and
look forward to an operation that adheres to the
rules and I think that's pretty much where we are
at at this point.
