7	Council Members will have to sign a disclosure
8	form indicating whether or not a conflict exists
9	with any of the groups on the attached list. If
10	any Council Member has a potential conflict of
11	interest with any of the organizations listed, he
12	or she might want to disclose a conflict at the
13	time of their vote. As a reminder, Council
14	Members are now required to disclose any conflicts
15	they may have with proposed subcontractors that
16	are used by organizations they sponsor for
17	discretionary funding. This disclosure must be
18	made before the subcontractor can be approved.
19	Members will be contacted by the Council's Ethics
20	and employment counsel, Nadir, to complete
21	disclosure forms. We have also been joined by
22	Karen Koslowitz. This is the only item on the
23	agenda today and members of the counsel of Finance
24	are available to answer any questions you may have
