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2	CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: Okay. This
3	meeting will come to order. Good afternoon,
4	welcome to the Subcommittee on Planning,
5	Dispositions and Concessions, I'm Council Member
6	Stephen Levin, Chair of the Subcommittee, joined
7	this afternoon by my colleague Sara Gonzalez of
8	Brooklyn, and colleague Peter Koo of Queens.
9	Pardon? And we will be hearing on a couple of
10	items today, I would like to begin with Land Use
11	#683, Mt. Hayden Property, that is 20135040 PNO,
12	and testifying on this item today, Robin Levine,
13	Deputy General Counsel of the New York City
14	Department of Environmental Protection and David
15	Wayne (sic), Assistant Commissioner of the New
16	York City Department of Environmental Protection.
17	This is an application pursuant to Section 72-H of
18	the New York general municipal law for the
19	proposed disposition of real property known as the
20	Mt. Hayden property, Green County, State of New
21	York, from the City of New York by and through the
22	New York City Department of Environmental
23	Protection to the State of New York by the New
24	York State Department of Environmental
25	Conservation. Mr. Wayne.

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2	MR. WARNE: Thank you very much,
3	Mr. Chairman. Good afternoon, good afternoon,
4	members of the Subcommittee, my name is David
5	Warne, I'm an Assistant Commissioner with the New
6	York City Department of Environmental Protection.
7	CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: Pardon me,
8	sorry about that.
9	MR. WARNE: That's quite all right.
10	CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: Just for the
11	record.
12	MR. WARNE: I've been called worse.
13	And I do work with DEP's Bureau of Water Supply,
14	which is our upstate arm which manages the
15	watershed and water supply portion of our system.
16	This item is the disposition of a couple of
17	parcels of land totaling about 814 acres, they had
18	been purchased by the city in 2002 and 2005 under
19	our land acquisition program, which is part of our
20	watershed protection initiative, and it is the
21	transfer of that land to the New York State
22	Department of Environmental Conservation for their
23	ownership and stewardship and management, as part
24	of their recreation program. They have
25	significant land holdings throughout the Catskill

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2	park and in portions of our watershed. I believe
3	you have a copy of my prepared testimony, I'd be
4	happy to go through that if that's helpful, or I
5	could answer any questions that you may have.
6	CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: Can you speak a
7	little bit of the process of acquisition back in
8	2002? Was there a cost associated with that?
9	What has it been used for for the last ten years?
10	MR. WARNE: Absolutely. In 1997
11	the city began a robust program of acquiring land
12	in the watershed for the purpose of water quality
13	protection. We buy only vacant land, with the
14	purpose of maintaining it in a vacant state, to
15	prevent development, to prevent water quality
16	problems associated with development. We've
17	bought, since 1997, slightly more than 120,000
18	acres of land in our watersheds, and it's been a
19	very successful component of the overall watershed
20	protection effort. These two parcels that
21	comprise the Mt. Hayden property were acquired in
22	2002 and 2005, as I said it's about 814 acres, and
23	they were acquired at a cost of slightly more than
24	\$1.1 million combined. And it has been maintained
25	as vacant property since that time, it has been

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2	we do allow certain passive recreational uses,
3	hiking, hunting, fishing, on the property.
4	CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: I think that
5	we're going to move speedily, do any of my
б	colleagues have any questions on this item?
7	Seeing none, Commissioner Warne, thank you very
8	much for your testimony, and we are going to close
9	this item. I thank you very much, I appreciate
10	it.
11	MR. WARNE: Great, thank you, I
12	appreciate your time.
13	CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: We have next up
14	Land Use #627, and I'm going to ask Chris
15	Gonzalez, Assistant Commissioner at HPD, to
16	testify on this item. Hi, Chris.
17	MR. CHRIS GONZALEZ: Good
18	afternoon, my name is Chris Gonzalez, Assistant
19	Commissioner of Government Affairs at HPD. I am
20	testifying on behalf of Land Use item #627, which
21	we are respectfully withdrawing. Did you have any
22	questions?
23	CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: I do not. Do
24	any of my colleagues have any questions on that
25	item? Seeing none, thank you very much, Mr.

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2	Gonzalez.
3	MR. CHRIS GONZALEZ: Thank you.
4	CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: Okay, so we're
5	closing Land Use #627, and then Land Use #680,
6	Jamaica Project, and #681, Hunter's Point South
7	Phase 1, that's Land Use #680 is 20135029 HAQ,
8	Land Use #681 is 20135038 HAQ, both in Queens
9	Council district Community Board district 12,
10	the other Community Board district 2, these two
11	items will be laid over to the meeting on
12	September 19 <sup>th</sup> . And with that I will ask … we have
13	one, two, I'll ask my colleagues to vote to
14	approve Land Use #683 and the Mt. Hayden property,
15	and a vote to withdraw Land Use #627, motion to
16	file pursuant to withdraw. Call the roll.
17	COMMITTEE CLERK: Chair Lander.
18	Excuse me, Chair Levin. Sorry.
19	CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: I vote aye on
20	all.
21	COMMITTEE CLERK: Council Member
22	Gonzalez.
23	COUNCIL MEMBER GONZALEZ: Aye on
24	all.
25	COMMITTEE CLERK: Council Member

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2	Koo.
3	COUNCIL MEMBER KOO: Aye on all.
4	COMMITTEE CLERK: By a vote of
5	three in the affirmative, none in the negative and
6	no abstentions, Land Use item #683 is approved and
7	referred to the full Committee, and Land Use item
8	#627, motion to file pursuant to withdrawal is
9	approved and referred to the full Land Use
10	Committee.
11	CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: So with that
12	this meeting is adjourned.
