agenda. We have a transparency reso and two Land Use items. We will start with the transparency reso. The resolution sets forth new change in the designation of certain organizations receiving local aging and youth discretionary funding, as well as new change in the designation of certain organizations receiving funding pursuant to certain initiatives in this budget. Organizations appear in the reso that have not yet completed prequalification process by the Mayor's Office of Contracts, the Council or any other entity are

identified in asterisks. Additionally as with all			
transparency resos the Council Members will have			
to sign a disclosure form indicating whether or			
not a conflict exists with any of the groups that			
are attached on the list. If any member has a			
potential conflict of interest with any of the			
organizations listed, he or she might want to			
disclose the conflict at the time of the vote.			
Council Members are now required to disclose any			
conflict with the proposed subcontractor that are			
used by organization they sponsor for			
discretionary funding. This disclosure must be			
made before the subcontractor be approved.			
Members will be contacted by the Council's Ethics			
and Employment Counsel, Nadir, to complete			
disclosure forms as necessary.			

Next we have two Land Use items.

The first property is the Kelly Street Apartments, which is a property located in Council Member

Maria del Carmen Arroyo's district in the Bronx.

The property which consists of five buildings and provides 81 units of rental housing to low income families will receive a full property tax exemption and undergo a rehab. Council Member

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2 Arroyo supports this item.

The next and last Land Use item is Ahi Ezer Kings Highway, a property located in my district. This property consists of one building of 50 units of rental housing to elderly and low income individuals, and they will receive a partial tax exemption and undergo a rehab. Of course, I support this item. These are the only items on the agenda today and members of counsel of Finance are available to answer any questions if you have a question regarding the Land Use or the transparency resos. Representatives from HPD are also here to answer any questions on the Land Use items. Does anybody have any questions? Seeing nobody have any questions, call the roll.
