# CHAIRPERSON RIVERA: Good

afternoon, ladies and gentlemen. My name is Joe
Rivera. I'll be the acting chair of today's Land
Use Committee. Let me introduce the members who
are here with us today. We have Council Member
Vincent Ignizio, Council Member Mark Weprin. We
have Council Member Al Vann, Council Member Rosie
Mendez, Council Member Margaret Chin, Council
Member Jumaane Williams. To my right we have
Council Member Annabel PalmaCouncil Member Sara
Gonzalez is here; she just stepped out for a
moment-Council Member Peter Koo, Council Member
Dan Garodnick and in front of us we have Council
Members Maria del Carmen Arroyo, Council Member
Steven Levin, Council Member Jessica Lappin.
Today we are going to be voting on a Land Use
number 688 through 699. They are related. It's
the C Word Park Project [phonetic], which is in
Council Member Margaret Chin's district approving
the modifications for these items as well. The
individual pieces are C120226 ZMM and N120227 ZRM.
Then we move on to L.U. number 690, which is
C120228 ZSM, L.U 691, which is C120229 ZSM
and then L.U. number 692, C120231 ZSM and then in

L.U. number 699, C120156 MMM. Before we vote, I'm
going to ask the council member whose district
this resides in, Council Member Margaret Chin, to
say a few words, and we have been joined by
Council Member Dan Halloran as well.

COUNCIL MEMBER CHIN: Thank you,
Chair. I also wanted to thank the Subcommittee
earlier for voting in support of this. This has
been a longtime coming. I mean this site has been
vacant for 45 years and in the last three years,
Community Board 3 along with its leadership and
local community has worked together together—
guidelines together with EDC and HPD and the city
to really come together to put forth development
on this site that will be a great benefit to the
community. So on the modification that is
presented that is we got an extra 100 units of
housing, which 50% of that will be affordable, so

the total number of affordable units on the site	
will be 500, and as permanently affordable, and	
the other amendment is related to retail	
diversity, so that will create more opportunities	;
for local small businesses in our community. At	
the same time, we also got other commitments from	ı
the city to create a community taskforce where th	ıe
community will have a continued involvement along	ſ
with Community Board 3 and the Council office,	
which is mine, District 1, and also Council Membe	r
Mendez' District 2, because she is on the	
neighboring district, will have input on the RFP	
process in terms of selecting the developer.	
There is also a commitment to former site tenants	;
to try to reach out to the thousands of families	
that were relocated, removed from the site to	)
get them to sign up so that they will have the	
opportunity to apply for the housing that is goin	ıg
to be built on this site, and with the Essex	
Street Market, the city also made a commitment to	)
offering the vendors who are there now, comparabl	.e
square footage of space, comparable rent and also	)
reasonable relocation costs to the new site, and	
also in RFP process to do a preference for	

proposal that includes local partners, such as
social service organization, community, local
developers, to develop the site, and with relation
to the income ban [phonetic], we got a commitment
to really give preference to a proposal that would
prescribe the income ban and focus more on the
lower income level in the multiple tiers. There
is also commitment to MWBE and also local hiring
with Hire NYC program. Furthermore, we also got a
commitment to designate about 15,000 square
footage on site 5 for a school and give SCA an
opportunity to determine if they could build a
school there, and to increase more affordable
housing for our community, the city, the
administration have also made a commitment to do
affordable housing on an offsite project. So I
really think that this has been a tremendous
effort by the local community working together
with the city, so I really urge all my colleagues
to vote to support it. Thank you.
