Transmitted here with is the bill signed by the Mayor. The bill is as follows:

Int. 648-A – Local Law 49

In relation to requiring that requiring the Human Resources Administration and the Department of Youth and Community Development to public on the agencies' websites information relating to the process for youth and young adults aged sixteen through twenty applying for or receiving public assistance.

Int. 649-A – Local Law 50

In relation to requiring the Human Resources Administration to clarify the process for serving youth and young adults aged 16 through twenty-four receiving public assistance as head of household.

Int. 657-A - Local Law 51

In relation to collecting and reporting data related to access of individuals aged sixteen through twenty-four to public assistance as head of household.

Int. 683-A - Local Law 52

In relation to the apparel used by operators of bicycles used for commercial purposes.

<u>Int. 733-A – Local Law 53</u>

In relation to the boundaries of the Far Rockaway empire zone.

<u>Int. 783-A – Local Law 54</u>

In relation to requiring commercial bicyclists to complete a bicycle safety course.

Int. 896-A - Local Law 55

In relation to the enforcement of commercial bicycle provisions.

Int. 910-A - Local Law 56

In relation to the use of bicycles for commercial purposes.
