2	CHAIRPERSON RECCHIA: Good morning
3	and welcome to today's Finance Committee Hearing.
4	My name is Domenic M. Recchia, Jr. I'm the Chair
5	of this wonderful Committee and I welcome everyone
6	here today. Today we have a very important
7	agenda. We have one important item that effects
8	everyone here, the Council's Operating Budget.
9	Under the charter the Council has until March 10 th
10	to submit the Mayor's to the Mayor's own operating
11	budget for this fiscal year. The budget must be
12	presented to the Mayor for an inclusion in the
13	executive budget with an amendment by the, if the
14	Council approves it. In January the charter date
15	was extended to March 21 st with legislation passed
16	by this committee. This year, the Council's
17	budget totals are just over \$51.5 million which
18	reflects a decrease of 1.1 percent or
19	approximately \$573,000 from last year. The
20	Council's budget reduction impacts central staff
21	operation and reflect over \$300,000 in OTPS
22	savings, including reduction in computer supplies,
23	office equipment maintenance and printing
24	contracts. The reduction reflects a few central
25	staff vacancies that will not be filled. Council

Member officers and staff will not be affected.		
Shh. The Council's Administrative Services		
Director, Ed O'Malley and Fiscal Officer Marcello		
Testa are here to answer any questions on the		
operating budget. Before I take questions I want		
to make sure that it does not go unnoticed that		
the City Legislative Body is charged with		
monitoring the operation and performance of City		
agency and analyzing and improving the City's		
budget, performing its responsibility in the land		
use process and, of course, passing laws. The		
Council has done all of this with a budget that		
totals less than one tenth of one percent of the		
City's total budget, which is over \$68 billion.		
This is a testament to the remarkable leadership		
of Speaker Quinn. Now, does anyone have any		
questions for Ed O'Malley or Marcello Testa? But		
before we take questions I want to recognize all		
those members that are joined us. We have Jimmy		
Oddo from Staten Island, Vincent Ignizio from		
Staten Island, Karen Koslowitz from Queens, Diana		
Reyna from Brooklyn and Queens, Helen Diane Foster		
from the Bronx, Al Vann from Brooklyn, Leroy		
Comrie from Queens, Ruben Wills from Queens,

8	particular time, considerably before the executive
9	budget is presented.
10	MALE VOICE 1: By charter we're
11	required to pass it. This is the last date that
12	we have to pass it.
13	COUNCIL MEMBER KOPPELL: Oh, is
14	that right? Okay. The second question I have is
