| 5  | Members Al Vann, Peter Koo, Dan Garodnick, Sara    |
| 6  | Gonzalez, Vinnie Ignizio, Diana Reyna, Charles     |
| 7  | Barron, Mark Weprin, Jumaane Williams, Joel Rivera |
| 8  | and Annabel Palma. And, oh, Levin and Lander,      |
| 9  | L&O. [background comment] We'll see. We are,       |
| 10 | just to let the members know, the next             |
| 11 | Subcommittee meetings will be held on June 18th,   |
| 12 | 19th and 20th. The Landmarks will be held on the   |
| 13 | 18th, June 19th will be Zoning, and there's an     |
| 14 | extra Planning meeting scheduled for June 20th.    |
| 15 | We have a full agenda of items that have been      |
| 16 | vetted at the Subcommittees this morning. Two      |
| 17 | items in Council Member Jackson's area, UDAPs,     |
| 18 | Land Use Item No. 811, in Community Board 9, Item  |
| 19 | No. 20135527 HAM, it's a UDAP for tax exemption    |
| 20 | for property located at 1772 Amsterdam Avenue, and |
| 21 | 80105 St. Nicholas, known as The Heights; also in  |
| 22 | Council Member Jackson's area, a UDAP, also in     |
| 23 | Manhattan Community Board 29, Land Use No. 813,    |
| 24 | Item No. 20135530 HAM, the tax exemption for       |
| 25 | property at 508 W. 134th Street. We also have in   |

| the Speaker's district a couple of items: Land     |
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| Use Item, Land Use No. 827, in, both in Community  |
| Board 2, they're both dealing with sidewalk cafés. |
| One is known as Rosemary's, it is Item No.         |
| 20135374, it is to maintain a sidewalk café at 18  |
| Greenwich Avenue; the next one is the motion to    |
| file for Land Use No. 828 known as RYU, Item No.   |
| 20135408 TCM. Then we have the Land Use Nos. 829,  |
| 830 and 831 are related, they're being laid over   |
| for BAM South, we're going to be voting on that    |
| later this month. We have an item in Council       |
| Member Fidler's district, and Brooklyn Community   |
| Board 13, Land Use No. 832, Item No. M840631(B)    |
| ZMK. It's to cancel the restrictive declaration    |
| to facilitate construction of an as-of-right four  |
| story, self-storage facility, at 2172713-2715      |
| Knapp Street, in Brooklyn Community Board 15.      |
| Back to Speaker's District, a sidewalk café, Land  |
| Use No. 836, Item No. 20135454 TCM in Community    |
| Board 4 in Manhattan, to operate a café doing      |
| business as 44&X Hells Kitchen, located at 622     |
| 10th Avenue. In Council Member Chin's district,    |
| the Water Street POPs text amendment, which we had |
| a presentation on, Land Use No. 837, Item No. N    |

| 130206(A) ZRM. This is to deal with the amendment  |
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| of the zoning, a temporary amendment of the zoning |
| resolution concerning privately owned public       |
| spaces within Community Board 1. In Council        |
| Member Vallone's district in Queens, also in       |
| Queens Community Board 1, we're dealing with Land  |
| Use No. 838, Item No. 2Item No. C 100398 ZMQ,      |
| it's the 28th Avenue rezoning, it's an amendment   |
| for the zoning map, establishing an R5 district    |
| within a C1-2 district. In Council Member          |
| Rivera's district, we're dealing with a tax        |
| exemption pursuant to Section 577 of the Private   |
| Housing Finance Law. [background comment] Right,   |
| right, and it's known as the East Tremont          |
| Portfolio, there are many addresses, they were all |
| vetted in the Subcommittee hearing. Land Use No.   |
| 839, Item No. 20135674 HAK, within Bronx Community |
| Board 6. And in Council Member Dickens' district,  |
| we have two items: Land Use Item No. 840, Land     |
| Use No. 840, Item No. 20135675 HAM, both in        |
| Manhattan Community Board 11, one is a tax         |
| exemption for the properties known as 1775 Houses; |
| the other one is a tax exemption also, Land Use    |
| No. 841, Item No. 20135676 HAM, for the properties |

| 2  | known as AK Houses, they are multiple addresses   |
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| 3  | with that, as well. And then the last thing that  |
| 4  | we have is in Council Member Rivera and Foster's  |
| 5  | district, it's dealing with the tax exemption for |
| 6  | properties known in the area as PRC Shakespeare   |
| 7  | Avenue, Land Use No. 843, Item No. 20135678 HAX,  |
| 8  | within Manhattan, within The Bronx Community      |
| 9  | Boards 3 and 5. Council Member Jessica Lappin has |
| 10 | joined us. Again, everything has been fully       |
| 11 | vetted in the Subcommittee meetings. Any member   |
| 12 | have anything to say on any item on today's       |
| 13 | agenda, that had not been said in the             |
| 14 | Subcommittee? Council [background comment]        |
| 15 | Council Member Williams would like to comment on  |
| 16 | each one. [laughter] Alrighty, seeing none, I     |
| 17 | would recommend a yes vote on everything on       |
| 18 | today's agenda. And I would ask the Clerk, Billy  |
