2 CHAIRPERSON MARK-VIVERITO: Good
3 afternoon. I'm Council Member Melissa Mark-
4 Viverito, chair of the Committee on Parks and
5 Recreation, and today the committee is going to
6 vote on proposed Intro number 1045-A, a bill which
7 will co-name 52 thoroughfares and public places
8 throughout the city of New York. We first heard
9 this bill last Friday, June 7, where numerous
10 witnesses spoke in favor of various co-naming
11 proposals contained within this bill. I believe
12 that there are no other outstanding issues on
13 this. I definitely would recommend all my
14 colleagues to vote aye on this. I just want to
15 recognize that we have been joined by Council
16 Member Danny Dromm, Council Member Julissa
17 Ferreras, Council Member Gentile, and as I
18 indicated - - , and Council Member Crowley. I
19 think there is only one council member--right,
20 Jackson is here, not a voting member, but here
21 supportive of one of the bills. I would
22 definitely encourage all the committee members to
23 vote aye and vote in support of this legislation.

18 COUNCIL MEMBER DROMM: Aye.

19 COMMITTEE CLERK: By a vote of five
20 in the affirmative, so in the negative and no
21 abstentions, the item has been adopted. Members,
22 please sign the committee report.

23 CHAIRPERSON MARK-VIVERITO: Okay,
24 and we will leave--sign the committee report,
25 Council Member Ferreras. She is off to rush to

11 COUNCIL MEMBER VACCA: Votes aye.


12 COMMITTEE CLERK: Final vote in the
