CHAIRPERSON FOSTER: Good morning. is Council Member Helen Diane Foster, Chair of the Committee on State and Federal Legislation. morning we are having a hearing on Resolution 1806-A, calling upon the United States Government to introduce and pass and the President to sign legislation that would extend the Terrorism Risk Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2007. month we had a very in depth and informative hearing on the importance of this Act and the need for the Act to be reauthorized, passed, and signed, not for just the economic wellbeing of New York City but of the country as a whole, and I will call on Council Member Recchia to see if he has any comments and then I will call on the vote and I encourage all the members to vote Aye.
