The last sidewalk cafe in the speaker's district is known as Piccola Cucina. Land Use No. 870, File No. 20135658 TCM, to continue to operate a sidewalk cafe at 196 Spring Street.

Also in Community Board 2, we are laying over the Governor's Island items, 861 and 862, in Council Member Chin's district until tomorrow as I said.

We are moving on to vote in the full committee on Culture Shed Text Amendment which encompasses Manhattan Community Board 4, Land Use No. 863, File No. N 130178 ZRM. This is to create an opportunity to do the Zoning resolution for the establishment of the Culture Shed Facility and the Hudson Yards Rezoning.

Land Use No. 864 is a spot rezoning in Council Member Dilan's (SIC) district on Pitkin Avenue to allow for affordable housing in Brooklyn Community Board 5, File No. C 130161 ZMK, and it's for a specific property along Pitkin Avenue between Berriman, Pitkin and Shepherd Avenues.

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We also have a spot rezoning in Council Member Vallone's District in Queens Community Board 1, is known as a 23rd Avenue rezoning. Land Use No. 865, File No. C 100178 ZMQ, to allow for spot rezoning along 23rd Street and 33rd Avenue and within that block.

We have a laid over for Council Member Levin, an HPD exemption known as 640 Broadway, Land Use Item 868, which will be laid over to vote.

Today, we have in Council Member Vann's District, Land Use No. 869 in Brooklyn Community Board 3, Item No. 20135777 HAK. It's to a property disposition for a HUD property at Fulton Street South, no address, Block 1861, Lot 119.
