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CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: Good afternoon, welcome to the Subcommittee on Planning, Dispositions and Concession; I'm Council Member Stephen Levin, Chair of this Subcommittee; I am joined this afternoon by my colleagues on the Subcommittee, Council Member Peter Koo of Oueens; Council Member Sara Gonzalez of Brooklyn; we have one, two, three, four, five items on the agenda today; they are all in Brooklyn. I will call the first item; it's three Land Use Items, Numbers 0940, 0941, 0942; that's C 130375 HUK and related applications C 130376 HAK and C 130374 ZMK, Livonia Commons Project in Council District 42; that's Council District represented by Committee Member Charles Barron in Community Board District 5 and testifying on this item is Assistant Commissioner Chris Gonzalez of HPD, Jack Hammer of HPD and Jacqueline Alexander of HPD... or I'm sorry, for this item Jackie's not testifying; it's just Jack Hammer and Chris Gonzalez of HPD.

CHRIS GONZALEZ: Good afternoon Chair Levin, members of the Subcommittee; I am Chris Gonzalez, Assistant Commissioner at HPD and I'm

Land Use Item Numbers 0940, 0941 and 0942 consist of the proposed disposition and related ULURP actions of City-owned property located at Block 3804, Lot 1; Block 3805, Lot 1; Block 3819, Lots 121 and 130; Block 3820, Lot 123, as well as Block 3801, Lots 1, 3, 47 and 49, also known as Livonia Commons.

Under the low-income rental program the developer is selected through a competitive process, will construct four buildings containing a total of 274 rental dwelling units, plus 4 units for superintendents, approximately 13,772 square feet of commercial space, approximately 11,546 square feet of community facility space and approximately 12,678 square feet of open space.

Additionally this project will include the construction of one building containing approximately 60,000 square feet of community space by the Boys Club of New York.

Council Member Barron has been briefed and has indicated his support. And we'll take whatever questions you've got.

MALE VOICE: And the Chair has stepped out for a moment; we're just gonna hold and take a break for a second. Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: Thank you very much Mr. Gonzalez; Mr. Hammer, I just spoke to Council Member Barron who had something, an emergency in his district so he was unable to come to the hearing.

We're gonna leave a vote on this item aside, so we're not gonna be voting today; Council Member Barron indicated to me that he still has some outstanding concerns regarding this item and that he would like to be able to have the opportunity to meet with the developer of the project before moving forward, so he just wanted... unfortunately he was unable to attend, but he wanted me to convey that message on the record here today.

CHRIS GONZALEZ: Okay, we'll make sure that meeting happens.

CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: 'Kay; thank you very much. Guess we're gonna... we're gonna close the hearing on Land Use Numbers 0940, 0941 and 0942 and move forward to a number of items in... as part of the Multi-Family Preservation Loan Program, Land Use

SUBCOMMITTEE ON PLANNING, DISP AND CONCESSIONS Number 0919; that's Application Number 02145061 HAK and Land Use Number 0943, 20145082 HAX. There are a variety of sites in Council Districts 33, 34, 36, 37, 41 and 42, as well as 16 and 17 for Land Use Number 0943; those are the Council Districts represented by myself, Council Member Diana Reyna, Council Member Al Vann, Council Member Erik Dilan, Council Member Darlene Mealy, Council Member Charles Barron, Council Maria Del Carmen Arroyo and Council Member Helen Diane Foster in Brooklyn, 3, 4, 3, 4, 1, 16, 5 and in the Bronx, 1, 2, 4 and 4.

Testifying on this item we have Chris Gonzalez and Jacqueline Alexander of HPD.

CHRIS GONZALEZ: Good afternoon, Chair Levin and members of the Subcommittee. I am Chris Gonzalez, Assistant Commission at HPD and I'm joined by Jacqueline Alexander, Assistant Commission for Property Disposition and Finance.

Land Use Item 0919 consists of the proposed disposition of seven City-owned buildings located at 178 Rockaway Avenue, 275 Menahan Street, 663 Willoughby Avenue, 76 Grove Street, 717 Flushing Avenue, 160 Glenmore Avenue and 877 Dumont Avenue,

also known as King's Village. 25

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Under HPD's Multi-Family Preservation Loan Program the sponsor will undertake this substantial rehabilitation of the buildings and when completed will provide approximately 40 residential dwelling units affordable to families making up to 60 percent of AMI.

There will also be two commercial units that are estimated to be rented approximately at \$926. Council Members Levin, Reyna, Vann, Dilan, Mealy and Barron have indicated their support.

CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: Do my colleagues have any questions on these items? 'Kay. Seeing none, I wanna acknowledge and congratulate St. Nick's for being here and for taking on these projects, which are not, I know, easy to develop, but it does help us achieve our goal as a city for and as community-based organizations and here in the Council of creating and preserving more affordable housing; obviously we sure we share that goal with HPD and I commend you for taking on what is not a very easy undertaking.

And with that we'll close the hearing on these two items and we'll be laying aside the first two and voting on these two, so...

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CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: Excuse me, I'm sorry; testifying on 0943, Chris Gonzalez and Jacqueline Alexander.

CHRIS GONZALEZ: Thank you. Good afternoon; I'm Chris Gonzalez, Assistant Commission at HPD, joined by Jacqueline Alexander, Land Use Item 0943 consists of the proposed disposition of four City-owned buildings located at 384 Grand Concourse, 1038 Rogers Place, 1129 Morris Avenue and 1202 Clay Avenue, also known as Grand and Rogers. Under HPD's Multi-Family Preservation Loan Program the sponsor will undertake the substantial rehabilitation of the buildings and when completed will provide approximately 66 residential dwelling units affordable to families making between 60 and 80 percent of AMI, including one superintendent's unit. Council Members Foster and Arroyo have indicated their support.

CHAIRPERSON LEVIN: Thank you very much, we'll close these two hearings and vote on Land Use Numbers 0919, 0943 and we'll be laying aside Land Use Numbers 0940, 0941 and 0942; we'll be laying aside...
