hearing. My name is Dominick M. Recchia, Jr. I am
the chair of the committee. Today we have three
items on our agenda. We have two Land Use items and
one BID item. We'll start with the Land Use item.
The first is there a Two Mill House in
Councilmember Melissa Markilito's (sp?) district in
Manhattan. The building code provides 40 units of
rental housing to low income families. The property
will undergo a rehab and article 11 property tax
exemption through HVD for 30 years Melissa
Markilito supports this item. The next land use
item is the renewal project which is located in
councilmember Joel Rivera and Fernando Cabrera's
districts; in the Bronx. The project consists of 7
buildings, currently provides 130 units of rental
housing to low income families. The property will
undergo a rehab and will receive an article 11

property tax exemption for HVD for 40 years. Both

Hudson yard's BID. The resolution sets the level 14th at 10 a.m. as the date and time for the hearing. To consider legislation that will establish the Hudson yard's BID in Speaker Chris Quinn's district. The hearing will be held in this room. The budget for the first year of operation is 1.2 million dollars with a maximum annual budget in subsequent years of 3 million dollars. Only commercial and mix use property owners will pay the assessment which averages out about 5,259 dollars for the 90 percent of the property owners who will pay the assessment. If established the Hudson yard's BID will be the city's 69th bid. These are all the items on today. Representatives from each of you are here to answer any questions on the new items.
