CHAIRPERSON JAMES: Good afternoon and
welcome to the hearing of the City Council's
Committee on Sanitation and Solid Waste Management.
I am Letitia James, Chair of the Committee. Today
we will be holding a vote for proposed Intro Number
1140-A. Before I begin, I'd like to recognize my
colleagues, Council Member Maria del Carmen Arroyo,
Council Member Mike Nelson, and Council Member
Brewer who is just sitting here doing paperwork.

Proposed Intro Number... yes, that's not working? Okay, proposed Intro will fix a minor shortcoming of the City's proposed illegal posting law. In most neighborhoods throughout the city, signs and other written material are prohibited from being posted upon city property such as sidewalks, telephone poles and sign posts, but our illegal posting law does not alter circumstances that occur in a smaller portion of neighborhoods. With the city property in question that a bunch of street is grass rather than a sidewalk, and I think in particular they were talking about the great borough of Staten Island. Up to now, DSNY's enforcement was prevented from issuing tickets for signs posted on city property. Proposed Intro
