

The bill we are voting on today seeks to facilitate this by requiring the City to publish a detailed annual report which shows both the value of goods and services that are provided by preferred source vendors but were procured from non-preferred source vendors. When we heard this bill last month, we learned from the Mayor's Office of Contract Services that under current practice it does not track or routinely review agency compliance with the preferred source vendor law. By creating a more transparency, this bill will hopefully increase marked oversight in this area, provide preferred source vendors with the necessary tools to determine where they might be missing out
