Dear Mr. McSweeney:

Pursuant to Section 37 of the New York City Charter, I hereby disapprove Introductory Number 1208-A, which would amend the Earned Sick Time Act, as enacted by Local Law Number 46 for the year 2013; to make certain changes relating to sick time for employees in the manufacturing sector and required notice to employees. On June 6, 2013, I vetoed Local Law Number 46, because the law will impose significant new costs on employers, establish a vast new bureaucracy in the Department of Consumer Affairs, impose additional economic costs for doing business in New York City and harm the very employees it seeks to help. The serious issues associated with Local Law Number 46, which are not corrected by this bill, are as concerning today as they were six months ago.

For the foregoing reasons, I hereby disapprove Introductory Number 1208-A.
