CHAIRPERSON LANDER: Alright. Good Morning.
(Gavel)

CHAIRPERSON LANDER: Good morning, with my apologies to my colleagues and the staff for my tardiness. I went down this morning to try to support some striking Cable Vision workers and anyway I've been behind all day, but I apologize to all of you. My name is Brad Lander, I'm Chair of the New York City Council's Committee on Rules, Privileges and Elections and $I^{\prime} m$ pleased to re-open this meeting. Joining us this morning are Council Members, Dan Garodnick, Inez Dickens, Margaret Chin, Mark Levine, Rafael Espinal and Ydanis Rodriguez.

I would also like to acknowledge the committee's attorney, Jason Atanyo (Phonetic) and thank the staff members from our investigative unit, Chuck Davis, Director of Investigations, Deandra Johnson and Diana Arriaga for their work.

We have two items on our calendar this morning. We've been joined by the Minority Leader Vinny Ignizio. The first is the reappointment of Anna Hayes Levin to the New York City Planning Commission, Item M 110. In a letter dated July 29,

2014 Manhattan Borough President formally submitted the name of Anna Hayes Levin to the Council for our advice and consent regarding her reappointment to the City Planning Commission. Next door on Thursday, September 4, 2014 Ms. Levin appeared before us, provided testimony, fielded question and I thought we really had a good strong productive dialogue. And certain I, and I know some other members were very favorably impressed with her. So today this Committee will administer a vote that will determine whether this committee recommends to the Council to give our advice and consent. If reappointed to the City Planning Commission, Ms. Levin will serve a five-year term, expiring on June 30, 2019. Unless any members have further questions or comments, we'll now take the vote on M 110 regarding the reappointment of Anna Hayes Levin to the City Planning Commission.

Any questions or comments. Seeing none, we'll ask counsel to call the roll on this item. COMMITTEE COUNSEL: Chairman Lander. CHAIRPERSON LANDER: Aye. COMMITTEE COUNSEL: And Council Members, Dickens.

Along with the designation of its chair and membership. The deletion of a subcommittee. And changes to allowances as set forth in the pre-considered resolution, which you have in your briefing package. It's the paper that's paper clipped to the committee report. As you'll see it creates a new standing committee, Courts and Legal Services with jurisdiction over courts and legal services. Amends the jurisdiction of fire and criminal justice services, bringing legal aid over to the new committee and public safety. Bringing courts over to the new committee. That committee will be chaired by Council Member Rory Lancman, and its members will be Council Members Gibson, Kallos, Menchaca and Ignizio. And in addition we are eliminating the sub Committee on Drug Abuse which was already under the committee on Health and will be heard as part of that committee.

So that is the pre-considered resolution
along with the appropriate allowance revisions.

Alright seeing none, we will now move to a vote on this pre-considered Resolution which does not yet have a number, but the pre-considered Resolution in your packet amending Rule 7.00 for the purposes that $I$ just outlined. And we'll ask the clerk to call the roll.
