are voting on today with the proposed resolution for
each item. What the committee is voting on today is
to approve each of the resolutions before you for
presentation for vote by the full Council. The
resolutions reflect the recommendation of the
applicable subcommittee. In addition today, you will
also find a briefing sheet, which give you additional
information about those matters and other matters
which have scheduled to be heard by the subcommittee.

Today we have the following applications on our calendar for our consideration. There are two sidewalk cafes. First, there's LU Number 114, Cherche Midi, an application to operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 282 Bowery with eight tables and 16 chairs in Manhattan Community Board 12 in

3	Hearth, an application to operate an unenclosed
4	sidewalk café located at 403 East 12th Street with
5	eight tables and 16 chairs in Manhattan Community
6	Board 2 in Council Member Mendez's district. We have
7	two applications from HPD, LU Number 123, Northern
8	Manhattan Equities, an application submitted by HPD
9	for one exemption for property tax pursuant to
10	Article 11 of the Private Housing Finance Law for 19
11	multi-family buildings in Harlem with 407 units. The
12	buildings are located in Manhattan Community Board 10
13	in Council Member Dickens' district. LU Number 119,
14	161-79, 86th Avenue, an application for HPD for the
15	disposition of a site, which consists of an abandoned
16	single-family home and two adjacent vacant lots
17	through the HPD Asset Sales program to enabling
18	property owner. This site is located in Queens
19	Community Board 8 in Council Member Lancman's
20	district. And finally, we are voting on the 19 East
21	Houston Street project in Council Member Chin's
22	district, which involves a four Land Use application
23	consisting of three special permits pursuant to the
24	zoning and disposition action for city-owned land.
25	The project involves the construction of a new six-

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story commercial building in the SoHo Cast-Iron
Historic District. Council Member Chin was able to
negotiate improvements to the project in response to
her concerns and that of the community, including the
removal of the third floor retail space initially
proposed, as well as commitments from the developer
and DOT to make pedestrian circulations improvements
in and around the project site in order to reflect
the agreement Council Member Chin has reached with
the developer.
