Today we have the following applications on our calendar for consideration.

Land Use No. 151, the Sollazzo Plaza rezoning, an application submitted by the Estate of Letizia Sollazzo for an amendment of the Zoning Map to eliminate from within and existing R3-2 District the C1-1 District and establishing an existing R3-2 to a C1-2 District. This application is in Council Member Rose's district in Staten Island Community Board 1.

Land Use No. 147, 304 to 306 East 8th Street, an application submitted by HPD for an

exemption for property located at 304 to 306 East 8th

Mendez's district in Manhattan Community Board 3.

Land Use No. 159, the Clinton Site 7, an application submitted by HPD for a property tax
