TITLE:

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the distribution of localized emergency preparedness materials.

BILL SUMMARY:

This bill would require the Office of Emergency Management (OEM) to create local emergency preparedness public awareness materials with information relevant to neighborhoods where there is a particular risk of an emergency event. The materials would provide information such as the locations of the nearest evacuation centers, the borders of evacuation zones and contact information for local organizations that could provide assistance during or after an emergency. The materials would also be translated into the languages spoken within that community, and made available online.

CODE SECTIONS AFFECTED:

EFFECTIVE DATE:

Ninety days after enactment.
