TITLE:

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to allowing parking at missing or broken muni-meters up to the maximum time permitted in that parking meter zone.

BILL SUMMARY:

Currently, motorists may park for no cost at up to the maximum time permitted in that parking meter zone if all meters within the parking field or block are broken or missing, requiring motorists to check for operational muni-meters on both sides of the street on an entire block.

Under the proposed local law, a motorist could park for no cost at up to the maximum time permitted in that parking meter zone free if 50 percent of more of muni-meters on the side of the street of the block or parking field are broken or missing.
