This bill would require the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) to establish an "Immigrant Affairs Coordinator" who would act as a liaison between DPR and immigrant communities to help them engage more with park services.

• Adds section 18-142 to the Administrative Code.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

180 days after its enactment into law.
