This bill would keep public beaches and pools under the jurisdiction of the Parks Department (DPR) open on each weekday until the day before the beginning of each school year and open throughout each weekend until September 30 of each year.

• Adds section 18-142 to the Administrative Code.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

90 days after its enactment into law.
