Land Use No. 188: 1371-61 Northern Boulevard an application submitted by CG&J Realty LLC to rezone a portion of a block on Northern Boulevard between London Place and Leavitt Street from an R6 C2-2 District to a C4-3 District. The proposed zoning change will facilitate the development of an 11-story approximately 152,000 square feet mixed-use
