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CHAIRPERSON GARODNICK: Good morning everyone and welcome to the Subcommittee of Zoning and Franchise. It's a subcommittee of the Land Use Committee of the New York City Council. Today's date is Monday, June 22nd. My name is Dan Garodnick and I have the privilege of temporarily chairing this committee for today in the absence of its former chair Mark Weprin who has moved on to employment in Albany. And I'm pleased to recognize the members of the committee who have joined us today; Council Members Gentile, Reynoso, Wills, Richards, and the Chair of the Land Use Committee Council Member David Greenfield. We have three items on the agenda today. They are all sidewalk cafes and we should be able to move through them in short order. The first item is Land Use number 238, application 2015523 TCM Eli's Essentials. It is a petition from Eat Lexington 87 LLC doing business as Eli's Essentials for revocable consent to continue and maintain and operate unenclosed sidewalk café at 1291 Lexington Avenue with four tables and eight chairs for a four year term. We're going to invite Robert Callahan of Eat Lexington 87

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to present the agreement that he has reached with Council Member Kallos. Mr. Callahan welcome. And as soon as you are ready go ahead and get started.

ROBERT CALLAHAN: Thank you very much. My name is Robert Callahan and I'll be representing Eat Lexington 87 LLC this morning. I'm going to read from a letter that was previously submitted to the committee which is an agreement between Council Member Kallos and Eli's as far as the sidewalk café is concerned. Dear Honorable Council Member Kallos. Please accept this letter as confirmation that as our... as per our agreement for the sidewalk café application for four tables and eight chairs we will... Only our customers will use the four tables and eight chairs we are permitted. We will police this to be sure. We will clean in and around the tables periodically during the day. Between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. we will not put up the guard to... that separate the tables from the sidewalk café according to the plan approved by the New York City Department of Consumer Affairs. We will at all times set up the café according to the approved plans. The tables will be placed against the building. We will have a three foot waiter

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aisle located between the guards and the tables which is always maintained when the guards are up.

The ice cream machine will be moved from the East 87 Street doorway. If anything else is required please contact my representatives at (914)632-6036.

We understand that we have two violations pending... the standing menu outside of the restaurant and having the doors between the restaurant and sidewalk café area closed. After we had been notified of the violations we immediately removed the standing menu from the street and opened the doors in between the restaurant and the sidewalk café area. We are intending to keep the set up this way and to make sure services to the sidewalk café is through the service aisle and not the front door to avoid any future violations. ...our managing partner Hassan El Garrahy has made the announcement of the new
