Today we have two items on the agenda, a transparency resolution and a land use item. Let's start with the transparency resolution, which sets forth the new designation and changes in the designation of certain organizations receiving local aging and youth discretionary funding and funding pursuant to certain initiatives in the budget.

Organizations appearing in the resolution that have not yet completed the prequalification process conducted by the Mayor's Office of Contract Services, the Council or another entity are identified in the attached chart with an asterisk.

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As with all transparency resolutions, council members will have to sign a disclosure form indicating whether or not a conflict exists with any of the groups on the attached list. If any council member has a potential conflict of interest with any of the organizations listed, he or she has the opportunity to disclose the conflict at the time of their vote.

As a reminder, please disclose any conflicts you may have with the proposed subcontractors that are used by organizations sponsored by discretionary funding. These disclosures must be made before the subcontractor can be approved. Wilhun [sp?] Grant from the General Counsel's Office can assist you with any questions or concerns regarding disclosures.

Next we have the land use item, which is a Tremont Renaissance located in Council Member Torres' district in the Bronx. This project will provide 225 units of housing to low- and moderate-income households and will receive a full 40-year property tax exemption through the city's HDFC Program. Council Member Torres supports the project and we'll have him say a few words, but I also wanted

COUNCIL MEMBER TORRES: Thank you, Madame Chairwoman; just wanna underscore how strongly I support Tremont Renaissance; it's a project in which I feel deeply invested. For me it's a symbol of how far the Bronx has come from the days of disinvestment and how far the Bronx will go, and I'm particularly excited about the mixture of AMIs within the building, 'cause I think it fits into my vision as well as the Borough President's vision for fostering more economic diversity in the Bronx; I think that's critical to revitalizing the borough, so I'm strongly supportive -- 256 units, LEED certification and only 15 minutes away from a metro door [sic], so it's an ideal location. So if you're looking to move to the Bronx, Tremont Renaissance is your best bet. you.
