2	Good morning everyone. Thank you to all
3	the members of the Committee on Public Safety.
4	Welcome to City Hall. I am Council Member Vanessa
5	Gibson of the 16 th district in the Bronx and I am
6	proud to serve as Chair of the Committee on Public
7	Safety. I thank you all for being here today to vote
8	on very important legislation. We have a very long
9	agenda so I'm going to get right into it. The first
10	bill that we're going to voting on is proposed into
11	73A to expand reporting from the Department of
12	Education and NYPD and enhance our City's Student
13	Safety Act. Can I have quiet please, colleagues?
14	Thank you. The safety of our students is of
15	paramount importance to everyone and we depend on our
16	schools safety agents to strike a delicate balance
17	between education and safety. This bill requires a
18	balance and holistic data set so that we can assist
19	the safety and educational environment of all of our
20	students through transparency and accountability,
21	this legislation will enable us to direct our
22	energies towards education and providing sufficient
23	resources to better enable the prevention and de-
24	escalation of problems situation before get out of
25	hand This logislation will holp to onsure our

disciplinary system that treats all students equally
with respect and dignity.

Through this legislation the Department of Education and the NYPD would be required to report the number of times students receive multiple suspensions. The number of times students transfer schools in connection to the suspension. The number of times EMS is called to address student behavior. The number of times mechanical restraints or handcuffs are used on students. The number of metal detectors in our schools. What contraband is seized from the use of metal detectors or magnetometers and complaints made against school safety agents and those injuries that may be sustained by school safety agents due to student misconduct.

This bill is the product of a true collaboration and partnership between this Council, the Department of Ed, The NYPD, School Safety Agents, Union Officials and Advocacy Groups.

I am very proud to have fostered this conversation along with my colleagues, Chair of Education, Council Member Danny Dromm and Council Member Corey Johnson.

To emphasize the importance of this bill to me, it is the very first bill to which I am the lead sponsor that is heard in this committee on Public Safety and I'm extremely proud that we will be voting on this today.

In addition, we will be voting on intro 897, which is a local law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York in relations to declaring nuances related to the sale of synthetic drugs and imitation synthetic drugs.

We will also be voting on intro 917, a local law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York in relations to imposing penalties for the manufacture, distribution or sale of synthetic cannabinoids and synthetic marijuana.

Sorry, that word is too long. So before we get to one of the lead sponsors who's here, I want to make sure we acknowledge all of the members who are here of this committee. We have Council Member Jimmy Vacca is here, Council Member Ferreras Copeland, Council Member Jumaane Williams, Council Member Chaim Deutsch, Council Member Raphael Espinal, Council Member Richie Torres and Minority Leader Council Member Steve Matteo. And we also have the lead

I hope that that will be a useful tool for them as we take aim at this drug which is just simply wasting people away. So we thank you very much for your leadership.

It is a potentially dangerous drug that is easily accessible to residence in our community. It's an attractive wrapper; it is spun as aroma therapy and all sorts of things that are very dangerous for our children. And so we as council are going to be very proactive and aggressive in making sure that we tackle this in an aggressive fashion going after the distributors and the manufactories. We are very clear as a council that we are not victimizing those users because we recognize that many individuals are using K2 for a reason. And so as we move forward, I am thankful for the leadership for our speaker and all of the members of this body for recognizing that we must do everything possible to rid our communities of K2 synthetic cannabinoids. So thank you very much to each of my colleagues for being here and for your support and we've also been joined by Council Member Rory Lancman and with that I will have our Committee Clerk, Billy Martin call the roll.
