Transmitted here with are the bills signed by the Mayor. The bills are as follows:

**Int. 108-A – Local Law 1**

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to prohibiting employment discrimination based on an individual's actual or perceived status as a caregiver.

**Int. 65-A – Local Law 2**

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to a program to reimburse nonpublic schools for the cost of security guard services.

**Int. 128 – Local Law 3**

A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to requiring that community planning boards receive an annual report submitted to the mayor with regard to projected and actual jobs created and retained in connection with projects undertaken by a certain contracted entity for the purpose of the creation or retention of jobs.

**Int. 603-A – Local Law 4**

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to increasing civil penalties for leaving the scene of an incident without reporting.

**Int. 604-A – Local Law 5**

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to reporting information related to leaving the scene of an incident without reporting.

**Int. 609-A – Local Law 6**

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to geothermal systems.


**Int. 908-A – Local Law 7**

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the review of data requested through FOIL for inclusion on the open data portal.

**Int. 916-A – Local Law 8**

A Local Law in relation to an open data law agency compliance examination.
