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3 CHAIRPERSON DICKENS: Good morning. I am Donovan Richards chairman of the subcommittee on 4 5 Zoning and Franchises and today we are joined by 6 council member Antonio Reynoso, who gets a gold star, 7 Council member Ritchie Torres, Council member Daniel 8 Garodnick and council member Vincent Gentile. And we 9 also special quests, the Land Use Chair David 10 Greenfield and we are also joined by Council member 11 Andrew Cohen, who actually has a rezoning of today. 12 Today, we will be holding a public hearing and voting 13 on two items today, Land Use Items No. 354 and 14 application for a sidewalk café and Land Use Item No. 15 355 rezoning in the Woodlawn neighborhood of the I would now open the public hearing for Land 16 Bronx. 17 Use No. 354 and application for a sidewalk café with 18 two tables and six chairs located in the community 19 board two of Manhattan and council member Corey 20 Johnson, and I just want to note that council member 21 Johnson supports the application. 2.2 So, first we will hear from, Andrew 23 Oh, I got it right SWA Architecture, Cohen. 24 (INAUDIBLE) this actually to state your name for the 25 record and the organization you representing and then

Subcommittee on Zoning and Franchises 4 1 you may begin sir and hit the button. You are going 2 3 to hit the button on the mic at the light of red. Andrew Cohen: It's alright Red. My name 4 Andrew Cohen. I represents SWA Architecture and we 5 are here in favor of the sidewalk cafe at 289 6 7 Bleecker. It is a simple sidewalk café, its 3 tables, 6 chairs on the corner of 7th Avenue South in 8 9 Bleecker Street. I don't know if there are any questions. 10 11 Chairperson Donovan Richards: Sure, 12 community board supports that there was any issues 13 surrounding everybody support of the community board 14 or the president. 15 Andrew Cohen: Ah, Yes. I believe that 16 they are. 17 Chairperson Donovan Richards: And you 18 just go through your hours of operation. 19 Andrew Cohen: I do not have that issue 20 available. 21 Chairperson Donovan Richards: Okay, no problem, so here was some issue obviously with this 2.2 23 at the beginning in which the community board voted it down and then you came back and made some changes. 24 25

Subcommittee on Zoning and Franchises 5 1 2 So, can you just read some of those changes on the 3 record. 4 Andrew Cohen: I believe that originally, it was requested 5 tables with 12 seats and it was 5 reduced to 3 tables and 6 seats. 6 7 Chairperson Donovan Richards: Then on 8 noise, can you comment on that on the record. 9 Andrew Cohen: Yes. They have agreed to 10 keep down the noise as much as possible by closing 11 some, keeping one of the doors closed at all times 12 from one of the two. It's a double door, they are 13 going to keep one door closed and the other door will 14 be a swing door, closing at behind them, not to 15 remain open. Chairperson Donovan Richards: 16 Thank you. 17 Anybody else have questions for this gentlemen. 18 Alright. Thank you for testimony. Anybody from the 19 public here to testify in this issue. Okay. If not, 20 we will close Land Use Items No. 354, which was sidewalk café and once again council member Johnson 21 2.2 supports this application. 23 [Pause] 24 25

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Chairperson Donovan Richards: Okay. 2 We 3 are back. Now, we will open the public hearing for 4 Land Use Item No. 355 and application of rezoning area and Woodlawn in the Bronx. This rezoning would 5 change the area from the existing R7A zoning to an 6 7 R4A district. This change would help to support the 8 character of the areas one and two family homes. This 9 rezoning is in community board 12 and Council member Cohen's District. Both the community board and the 10 11 council members support this application and with 12 that being set, I will now turn this portion of the 13 hearing over to council members Cohen for some 14 remarks. 15 Andrew Cohen: Thank you very much. Ι

16 will be ready. I really just want to express my 17 gratitude to City Planning for having this be a 18 collaborative effort for really hearing the community 19 and addressing you know problem and I think that we 20 got in time, we are where there is one building under construction that is sort of out of character but I 21 think, we are going be able to prevent others. 2.2 So, I 23 really again; you know the community board was in; the City Planning was in, my office was in and we all 24 worked together and I am really glad, we got this 25

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2	done today. And I really encourage my colleagues to
3	vote, Aye. Thank you very much.
4	Chairperson Donovan Richards: Thank you.
5	That's very good comments. Alright, we will now hear
6	for Michael Parkinson from Department of City
7	Planning and Shawn Brede, did I say it right? Close
8	enough. Okay. So, I will ask you to hit your mics,
9	say your name on the record and who you representing
10	and then you may continue with some statements, if
11	you have any statement? You have anything, you want
12	to read in?. Okay, sure. So, you may began.
13	Shawn Brede: Good morning. I am Shawn
14	Brede, I am deputy director for the Bronx office of
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	the Department of City Planning, welcome, thank you
16	for having us. I apologize again for being a little
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17	for having us. I apologize again for being a little late this morning. We are going to be talking very

We are going to be talking very briefly about a zoning map amendment in the Woodlawn neighborhood of community district 12 in the Bronx. I am just going turn it to Michael Parkinson, who is going to walk through some of those details. Thank you. Michael Parkinson: Sure. Thanks Shawn.

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2	late this morning. My name is Michael Parkinson, I
3	am a borough planner for Department of City Planning
4	in the Bronx for the record. The proposed action
5	before you today is a zoning map amendment from R7A
6	to R4A affecting 19 lots on portions of three blocks
7	in the Woodlawn neighborhood in Bronx community board
8	12. The action was undertaken in response to and
9	with great support by local community groups,
10	community board 12 and elected officials. Community
11	board 12 held a public hearing in December 3, 2015
12	and voted by a count of 23 to 0, to recommend
13	approval of the application and the borough's
14	president's office held a public hearing in December
15	22, 2015, subsequently issued a recommendation to
16	approve the application. So, the proposal to rezone
17	the area from R7A to R4A is intended to preserve the
18	historical character of the affected area. It is not
19	expected to induce or preclude new development but
20	would rather ensure that any construction or
21	development that does occur would do so in a manner
22	that reflects the existing low scale character of the
23	affected area. I am happy to sort of elaborate on
24	the proposal as much as you all would like but for my
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comment, I want my comments and are open for the
questions if there are any?

4 Chairperson Donovan Richards: Right, I want to thank you for statement and comments and 5 thanks the Department of City Planning. It is not 6 7 every day that we are down zoning nowadays, right. I want to congratulate council member Cohen on a great 8 9 job and preserving the character of his neighborhood in particular. I guess this is a historic in this 10 11 day and age, when we are looking to do somewhat more density but congratulation on this on and I will go 12 13 anyone have question?.

14 Chairperson Greenfield: I have questions 15 on this. So, thank very much for finally showing up 16 to our hearing, we appreciate it. That's a joke, I 17 know there is miscommunication, is a very serious 18 today. We just happy to hear. I am teasing, I am 19 teasing. We are happy to have you. Just where is 20 May, when you need her, okay, I would like bust your 21 jobs. I have question for you, how long does this 2.2 process takes? when do you begin the process and how 23 long does it take you to get this done?.

24 Michael Parkinson: Well the project is 25 actually certified in November, but the request has

Subcommittee on Zoning and Franchises 1 been around for a little bit of time and we really 2 3 wanted to take a look in the area and do a due 4 diligence but once it's went through, it did move relatively quickly. 5 Chairperson Greenfield: Okay. I am going 6 7 repeat my questioning, and may be this time I might 8 get an answer? How long does the project actually 9 take from the time it was proposed by the community; not from the certification point, but long it is 10 11 going to take from time that the community has come forth and say we want to do this, until the time that 12 13 actually it got certified, roughly. 14 Michael Parkinson: I would say about a 15 year. We were out in April talking about the 16 project, when it became a real project. 17 Chairperson Greenfield: That's it, one 18 year. 19 Michael Parkinson: Yes. 20 Chairperson Greenfield: Okay, kind of a 21 hard to believe but sure, I will take it. I want to thank you for the work that you have done here today 2.2

23 and I want to thank the council member for his advocacy and I joined the Chair and noting that this 24 is rear down zoning action that we don't generally do 25

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2	but this speaks to the fact that the administration
3	and City Planning is very responsible to the needs of
4	the local communities and when appropriate the City
5	Planning and administration will support down zoning
6	in the neighborhood to preserve the character of that
7	neighborhood, so we are certainly grateful for that.
8	Thank you very much.
9	Chairperson Donovan Richards: Alright;
10	thank you for your testimony and question.
11	: I just want to say? Just want to
12	congratulate council member Andrew Cohen, who's
13	district is going to stay exactly the same and I know
14	lot of extreme value to him, so I think this is
15	great. I am excited to see a down zoning and I am
16	excited to vote, Aye on this.
17	Chairperson Donovan Richards: We did not
18	call a vote yet by the way.
19	: A silent vote.
20	Chairperson Donovan Richards: Thank you
21	for your testimony. Thank you, you are free to go.
22	Anyone else here from the public here to testify and
23	take you on this item. Right, if not, we will close
24	Land Use Item No. 355 and I will ask the clerk to
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Subcommittee on Zoning and Franchises 12 1 call the roll, on both Land Use Items No. 354 2 3 sidewalk café and Land Use Item No. 355 rezoning. 4 5 Chair Richards: I happily vote, Aye. Council member Gentile: I love down 6 7 zoning, so I vote, Aye. 8 Council member Garodnick: Aye. 9 Council member Reynoso: Congratulations, 10 council member Andrew Cohen for keeping things the 11 same. I vote, Aye. 12 Council member Torres: So, I don't like 13 down zonings but I like Andrew, so I vote, Aye. 14 15 COMMITTEE COUNSEL: Land Use Item No. 354 16 and 355 are approved and referred to the full Land 17 Use committee by a vote of 5 votes in the 18 affirmative, 0 in the negative and 0 abstentions. 19 Chairperson Donovan Richards: Alright. 20 Thank you so much.
