CHAIRPERSON REYNOSO: Good afternoon and thank you all for being here this amazing day, thank you, Rod [sic]; joined by Council Member Brad Lander and members of the committee, from Staten Island, Steven Matteo, Vanessa Gibson from the Bronx and Council Member Costa Constantinides from Oueens. Thank you guys for being here and good afternoon and welcome to this committee vote on a preconsidered vote to delay the implementation of Local Las 63, which imposes a 5 cent fee on carryout bags. enacted, this bill would move the effective date of Local Law 63-2016 from October 1, 2016 to February 15, 2017 and would move the six-month period during which warnings would be given instead of fines for covered stores who don't comply with the law from the period beginning October 1, 2016 and ending March 31, 2017 to the period beginning February 15, 2017 and ending August 14, 2017. After you guys decipher that and get it on the record, it'll make sense; in writing it makes sense.

It would allow covered stores to give away reusable bags free of charge from February 15, 2017 to April 30 of 2017 and would move the deadline

COUNCIL MEMBER LANDER: Thank you, Chair Reynoso and I can't resist pointing out that if everyone were to follow the Minority Leader and vote no on this bill, then the bag fee will go into effect on October 15, so I don't know; I have to see what happens on the floor tomorrow.

No, in all seriousness, the plastic bag is getting a several month reprieve, but its days of littering New York City are numbered; this extra couple of months until February 15 will give us the time to do an even stronger implementation, even stronger outreach, even more reusable bag giveaways; we look forward to the conversation about things we can do to do an even better job of making sure we reduce plastic bag waste in New York City and I certainly appreciate that Speaker Heastie prevented

the senate from nullifying our bill entirely and from preventing any other municipality in the state from moving forward; some people may have seen that Suffolk County actually is moving forward to consider a fee bill and I hope other municipalities around the state will as well. We look forward to working with our colleagues in Albany to further strengthen implementation and we look very forward to implementing this law on February 15, 2017. Thank you very much, Mr. Chair.
