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hearing on... of the committee on Standards and Ethics. I am the Chair with the committee, Councilman Member Alan Maisel. Today we will be holding a second hearing and vote on 14 bills. These bills were first heard by this committee in November of this year. The first of these bills is proposed introduction 1345A sponsored by the Speaker, Melissa Mark-Viverito in relation to conflicts of interest and organizations affiliated with elected officials. This bill directly addresses the concern that organizations affiliated with elected officials could raise unlimited funds even from persons doing business with the city and even when the ultimate use of these funds is for the promotion of the... that elected official. The city's campaign finance laws contribute contributions from persons doing business with the city to protect against potential influence of that money and to prevent any appearance of corruption but under current law those limitations could not be applied to the contributions received by affiliated organizations like the campaign for one New York. That is why today we are voting on the law with the

same goal to protect against potential attempts to

stakeholders and this bill has been amended to

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2	address the concerns raised in those discussions.					
3	Among other requirements the bill now specifies that					
4	while candidates may complete contribution cards for					
5	contributors they could also do so after a					
6	contribution has been made and provided that the					
7	contributor then signs the completed card.					
8	Alterations or changes to the contribution card after					
9	it has been signed will not be permitted. This					
10	amended bill that we are voting on today is a					
11	reflection of the input the many stakeholders we have					
12	heard from. I want to thank the sponsor of these					
13	bills, Council Member Garodnick, Council Member					
14	Greenfield, Council Member Lancman, Council Member					
15	Lander, Council Member, Member Salamanca and Council					
16	Member Van Bramer. I will now call on the Sponsors
