I welcome everyone to today's hearing. 8 I want to thank and acknowledge the sergeant-at-arms, 9 Jessica, who's done a very good job today, Land Use 10 Director Raju Mann, Deputy Director Amy Levitan, 11 Attorney Julie Luben, Dylan Casey. I'm supposed to 12 circle one of you. I think it's Dylan today, and Project Manager Jakeem. (sp?) We are joined today by 13 14 Council Member-Subcommittee Members Mark Treyger and 15 Ydanis Rodriguez. Thank you for just leaving your 16 other committees and coming here. I appreciate it. We have one item on calendar today for a hearing and 17 18 vote, Land Use No. 546, Rainbow Plaza in Speaker 19 Mark-Viverito's district. The property is located at 575 East 140th Street, and 574 East 140th Street at 20 21 Community Board 1 in the Bronx. HPD is seeking 22 approval of the acquisition of the subject property 23 by a newly created Article 5 Corporation and approval 24 of a partial Article 5 Tax Exemption for 40 years. 25 These actions will facilitate the preservation of 126

ARTIE PEARSON: Yes. 6 7 LEGAL COUNSEL: Gary Sloman. 8 GARY SLOMAN: Yes. 9 [background comments] LEGAL COUNSEL: Do you swear to tell the 10 truth and the whole truth? 11 12 ARTIE PEARSON: I do. 13 GARY SLOMAN: And I do. 14 LEGAL COUNSEL: Will you go ahead and 15 just please introduce before testifying. ARTIE PEARSON: Artie Pearson, Director 16 17 of Land Use from HPD's Office of Governmental Relations. 18 19 GARY SLOMAN: Gary Sloman, Director of Operations, Division of Housing Supervision of HPD. 20 ARTIE PEARSON: Good afternoon, Acting 21 Chair Cohen and members of the subcommittee. Land 2.2 23 Use No. 546 consists of one multiple dwelling located at 574 and 575 East 140th Street in Speaker Mark-24 Viverito's district, and is known as Rainbow Plaza. 25

It is a six-story building containing 126 rental 2 units, and one superintendent's unit. Currently, 3 4 there is only one vacancy. There is a mixture of bedroom types including 1, 2 and 3-bedroom units 5 under targeted AMI of 60%. In 1984, the Board of 6 7 Estimate approved the development of Rainbow Plaza as 8 an Article 5 redevelopment company, which provides 9 the Section 8 based low-income rental housing. In 2009, the complex was conveyed to a new owner that 10 11 continues to operate the complex as Section 8 based 12 low-income housing. Although the owner has a Section 13 8 contract in place with the development, it has been brought to HPD's attention that the owner is not 14 15 organized as an Article 5 redevelopment company, but was organized pursuant to the Business Corporation 16 Law. Because Article 5 redevelopment companies must 17 18 be duly organized under the Private Housing Finance Law, HPD is seeking Council approval to allow Rainbow 19 20 Plaza to enter into a redevelop company contract 21 under Section 114 of the Private Housing Finance Law. 2.2 Additionally, HPD seeks approval of a new tax 23 exemption for a period of 40 years that will coincide with a new redevelopment company contract, and 24 Speaker Melissa Mark-Viverito has been briefed on 25

SUBCOMMITTEE ON PLANNING, DISPOSITIONS AND CONCESSIONS 6 1 this project, and has indicated her support, and both 2 3 Gary and I can answer any question that you may have. 4 CHAIRPERSON COHEN: Yes, are you-are you 5 speaking also or --GARY SLOMAN: No, not unless there's any 6 7 questions. 8 CHAIRPERSON COHEN: Okay. Thank you very 9 much, Artie. I'm going to give everybody the secret that I'm very inclined to support projects in the 10 11 Speaker's district that she supports, but I just have a couple of questions. One is I was wondering are 12 there any open violations on the property currently? 13 14 ARTIE PEARSON: There are a minimal 15 number of violations on the property. None of them a 16 C. Mostly from A&B and the owner is obliged to 17 correct all of these housing code violations. As a 18 matter of fact, they're in the process of doing that 19 now and seeking dismissal inspections to make sure 20 they're wiped from the record. 21 CHAIRPERSON COHEN: And who is the 2.2 current owner? 23 GARY SLOMAN: Well, the current owner isis an entity. The-the gentleman who owned the entity 24 are here, it's the owners of the entity, but it's the 25

Technically, it's a new-a new 4 corporation that's acquiring it, but really, it's the 5 same principals involved. 6 7 CHAIRPERSON COHEN: In this corporation the only assets will be this property? 8 9 GARY SLOMAN: That's correct. CHAIRPERSON COHEN: Okay. Do any of my 10 11 colleagues have any questions? Okay. 12 LEGAL COUNSEL: Are there any more 13 members of the public who would like to testify on 14 this item? 15 CHAIRPERSON COHEN: Seeing none. Yes, 16 alright. I'm going to go to page and find out what I'm supposed to do next. I note for the record that 17 18 the application we are voting on today has the full 19 support of the Speaker and my support. I will now 20 call on counsel to call the roll on the vote to 21 approve. 2.2 LEGAL COUNSEL: Chair Cohen. 23 CHAIRPERSON COHEN: I vote aye. LEGAL COUNSEL: Council Member Rodriguez. 24 25 COUNCIL MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Aye.
