| 6  | everyone. I'm Council Member Corey Johnson, Chair of  |
| 7  | the New York City Council's Committee on Health.      |
| 8  | Welcome to today's hearing on Resolution No. 1433,    |
| 9  | sponsored by my friend, Council Member Steve Levin, a |
| 10 | resolution in support of state legislation to include |
| 11 | the coverage of in vitro fertilization (IVF)          |
| 12 | treatment in the New York State insurance law.        |
| 13 | Unfortunately, fertility issues are                   |
| 14 | fairly common with about 12% of women aged 15-44      |
| 15 | years old in the United States; they have difficulty  |
| 16 | getting pregnant and carrying a pregnancy to term,    |
| 17 | yet New York State insurance law excludes coverage    |
| 18 | for in vitro fertilization treatments. IVF is an      |
| 19 | incredible medical resource that should not be        |
| 20 | exclusively available to those who can afford the     |
| 21 | \$15,000 price tag. Deciding to grow your family      |
| 22 | should be an exciting time, not a time to clean out   |
| 23 | your savings account. Resolution No. 1433 calls on    |
| 24 | New York State to join eight states that already      |
| 25 | required IVF health insurance coverage by law.        |

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| 2  | I want to thank Council Member Levin for              |
| 3  | his leadership in introducing this resolution and     |
| 4  | turn it over to him for a statement.                  |
| 5  | COUNCIL MEMBER LEVIN: Thank you very                  |
| 6  | much, Chair Johnson. I want to thank you and I want   |
| 7  | to thank Council Member Koo, Council Member Mendez;   |
| 8  | Council Member Van Bramer, who's here. I want to      |
| 9  | thank you very much for bringing this resolution to   |
| 10 | the Committee and calling on the New York State       |
| 11 | Legislature to pass and the Governor to sign Assembly |
| 12 | Bill 528, sponsored by Assemblywoman Linda Rosenthal. |
| 13 | The bill would amend the New York State insurance law |
| 14 | to expand health coverage to include in vitro         |
| 15 | fertilization.  |
| 16 | As you said, becoming a parent is a                   |
| 17 | joyous occasion; I was lucky to become a parent this  |
| 18 | year, but for many the pathway for becoming a parent  |
| 19 | is marked by loss, frustration and high medical       |
| 20 | bills. Fifteen percent of heterosexual and same-sex   |
| 21 | couples seek out and use IVF, but treatment can be    |
| 22 | time-consuming and very expensive. Just one cycle of  |
| 23 | IVF can cost between \$12-17,000; not including the   |
| 24 | cost of related hormonal medications a woman may also |
| 25 | need to take, and many couples must go through        |

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| 2  | multiple cycles of treatment. However, according to   |
| 3  | a 2015 survey, only 19% of large employers cover IVF  |
| 4  | and even companies that do sometimes have outdated    |
| 5  | insurance policies that fail to cover same-sex        |
| 6  | couples. Unfortunately, there is strong disparity in  |
| 7  | the use of fertilization assistance, limiting the     |
| 8  | number of women who require and can access this       |
| 9  | necessary medical treatment. Eight states, including  |
| 10 | California and Illinois, currently require coverage   |
| 11 | of IVF and it's time that New York State join them in |
| 12 | leading the way for healthy families.                 |
| 13 | And so I'd like to thank Speaker Melissa              |
| 14 | Mark-Viverito and Ramon Martinez, as well as our      |
| 15 | drafter, Emily Rooney, my former Legislative          |
| 16 | Director, Julie Bero for their work on this           |
| 17 | resolution.   |
| 18 | Just on a personal note, my wife and I                |
| 19 | went through in vitro fertilization and we were       |
| 20 | fortunate enough to have Emblem Insurance, which is   |
| 21 | the City employee insurance, and we also had SMMP,    |
| 22 | which is major medical for management in New York     |
| 23 | City and we were able to get coverage, and if it      |
| 24 | wasn't for that coverage, there's no way we would've  |
| 25 | been able to afford to have the coverage that         |

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| 2  | ultimately led to our daughter being born, Frances.   |
| 3  | And so it's my strong belief that everybody that      |
| 4  | wants to have a family should have the opportunity to |
| 5  | have a family and people facing fertility issues is   |
| 6  | something that we don't often talk about and there's  |
| 7  | not enough information out there in the mainstream    |
| 8  | and so we need to make sure that we have good         |
| 9  | information out there and that we mandate that        |
| 10 | insurance companies hear in New York State, we join   |
| 11 | with eight other states in the United States to       |
| 12 | mandate coverage to make sure that every family that  |
| 13 | wants to grow has the opportunity to do so. So thank  |
| 13 |   |
|    | you very much.  |
| 15 | CHAIRPERSON JOHNSON: Thank you, Steve,                |
| 16 | and this should not be a partisan issue; this is      |
| 17 | about families, so. Any comments from any of my       |
| 18 | colleagues that are here today?                       |
| 19 | COUNCIL MEMBER VACCA: I wish to be added              |
| 20 | to the resolution.                                    |
| 21 | CHAIRPERSON JOHNSON: Great. Council                   |
| 22 | Member Mendez would like to be added to the           |
| 23 | resolution as well and Council Member Koo would like  |
| 24 | to be added to the resolution as well.                |

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| 2  | So there are no advocates to testify here            |
| 3  | today. The Legislature is come back into special     |
| 4  | session sometime this week; I'm not sure they're     |
| 5  | taking this bill up, but it's still important for us |
| 6  | to be on the record; whether they take it up this    |
| 7  | year or next year it's important for us to pass this |
| 8  | resolution today; we just have to make sure they see |
| 9  | that we passed it, so we'll do that. With that, I am |
| 10 | going to now adjourn this hearing.                   |
