CHAIRPERSON REYNOSO: Good morning, I am Council Member Antonio Reynoso; I am the Chair of the Committee on Sanitation and Solid Waste Management. Welcome to this vote on Proposed Intro No. 1439-A, which I am a sponsor of and would require any City agency, when confiscating food deemed safe for human consumption by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to notify at least one food resource organization that may retrieve it before disposing of the food, and Proposed Intro No. 1514, co-sponsored by Council Member Espinal, which I am also a cosponsor of, that would require the Department of Sanitation in conjunction with the Department of Information Technology and Telecommunications to create and maintain a web portal that would allow prospective food donors and recipients to post notifications concerning the availability of food, including food that would otherwise go to waste, and to arrange for the transportation and retrieval of that food.

The Committee held its first hearing on these bills on April 26, 2017; we discussed at that time that approximately 40 percent of all food grown in the United States is thrown away. I am hopeful that these bills will not only reduce hunger in New York City by encouraging and facilitating more food donations, but also reduce food waste.

I want to thank my colleague, Council Member Rafael Espinal, for his leadership on this important issue and invite him to make an opening statement at this time.

COUNCIL MEMBER ESPINAL: Thank you.

Thank you, Chair Reynoso for taking the necessary steps to bring this bill to a vote in a timely manner.

Intro 1514-A will require the Department of Sanitation along with the Department of Information Technology and Telecommunications to maintain a web portal that will connect potential food donors with food recipients, like that Craig's List of food donation. This digital solution will help feed our hungry New Yorkers by allowing small businesses that would normally dump uneaten food to

Approximately 1.4 million New Yorkers rely on food pantries or soup kitchens to get some of their meals, yet 40 percent of the food in our country goes uneaten; not only is this wasteful, but it also contributes to global climate change when the food ends up rotting in our landfills.

As I have stated before, food waste is bad for the environment, bad for the hungry and bad for business owners who could otherwise be receiving tax breaks. This legislation is a win for our local businesses, City resources, environment, and most importantly, for New Yorkers in need of a helping hand.

Thank you again all for your support and for voting favorably for this bill. Thank you, Chairman.
