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COMMITTEE ON CIVIL SERVICE AND LABOR the Administrative Code of New York City in relation to safe time for victims of family offenses, sexual offenses, stalking, and human trafficking, as well as their family members, sponsored by Council Member Julissa Ferreras-Copeland in conjunction with Mayor de Blasio. This bill would expand the Earned Sick Time Act into Earned Sick and Safe Time Act so that it could be used by survivors of domestic violence, stalking, etc. Accrued time will be able to be used to seek crisis services, legal advice and shelter, among other resources. I'm very proud to be voting on this important piece of legislation that will expand upon the Council's biggest accomplishment; this Committee's biggest accomplishment in recent

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years.

And I'd like to thank Council Member

Ferreras-Copeland for her leadership in particular in moving this bill ahead. I'd also like to thank those who came in in June in support of this bill and testified on behalf, from the Mayor's Office to Combat Domestic Violence, Department of Consumer Affairs, the Office of Labor and Policy and Standards, Sanctuary Families, NYLAG, Safe Horizons, and others. Domestic violence is a terrible and
